Welcome to The City and County of Bristol Indoor Bowls Club Limited.

We are a company limited by guarantee and a Community Amateur Sports Club (CASC). We are a non-profit-making organisation with all profits invested in the running and improvement of our facility and the sport of bowls.

The Directors, who are all volunteers, meet monthly to make decisions regarding the operation of the club.

There is also a Bowls & Social Committee that looks after bowling activities and an extremely active and successful Junior section.

We also host sessions for bowlers with disabilities, use wheelchairs, VIBE (visually impaired) and short mat.

In addition to the many volunteers, the club has a small number of employees – the club manager (full time), bar staff and a cleaner (all part time) and there is a catering contractor and a bowls shop franchise.

External companies are contracted for major works, and all other aspects of the club are co-ordinated and undertaken by volunteers.

In becoming a member, you are joining a large family who all enjoy the sport of bowls and are willing to donate some time towards running our club.
